REFUNDS:

☐ The Adirondack Club will refund 100% of paid tuition **minus the \$50.00
Deposit per week** if The Adirondack Club receives the notification of the desire to
cancel in writing via mail by the end of business on May 1, 2025. (email is
acceptable if the email falls within the above guidelines)

☐ After May 1, 2025, refunds will only be considered for qualifying
documented medical reasons confirmed by a physician in writing.

☐ Ongoing “pandemic concerns” are NOT a qualifying medical reason for a
refund.

☐ There are no refunds or credits for missed camp day/weeks.

The Adirondack Club reserves the right to dismiss any camper whose conduct is deemed detrimental to the overall good of the Camp. In cases of gross misconduct, no refund will be provided. No refunds or credits will be provided for late arrivals or early departures.

The Adirondack Club maintains the highest safety standards; however, it does not assume liability for accidents, illness or the transmission of disease or viruses.

This Camp must comply with the regulations of the Massachusetts Department of Public Health (105 CMR 430 and the Franklin Department of Public Health.)

It is hereby understood and agreed that any accident or illness claim will be covered by the Parent's or Guardian's insurance.

The Adirondack Club will make a good faith effort to deliver Camp Services as stated above as well as in promotional literature and online content; however, in the event of circumstances outside our control (for example: pandemic, virus, natural disaster, venue changes) impacting our ability to deliver these services, we are not responsible for the outcome of these services as a result of necessary changes/modifications. The Adirondack Club is committed to the safety and wellness of our campers and staff at all times.
