SWIMMING AT CAMP

Arts campers participate in afternoon free swim and are supervised by our staff of lifeguards AND their counselors at all times. we'll also have access to the splash pad and our huge waterslide!!! Pack a towel and bathing suit each day.



CAMP LUNCH

Each camper is offered a variety of lunches throughout the week (additional fee).

Lunches are served through our Café at The Adirondack Club. Counselors help the campers choose their meals before eating on our private camp lunch deck. If your camper does not see something to their liking on the published lunch menu, please feel free to pack a peanut-free lunch. Don't forget to pack some snacks and a water bottle for your children to last throughout the day!

OUR CAMP COUNSELORS

You can rest assured that your camper is in great hands at The Adirondack Club. All of our carefully chosen counselors are CPR/First Aid/AED certified by the American Red Cross and screened using the state's CORI/SORI system. All counselors are trained in how to provide a safe and fun camp experience for all campers. Our Arts Camp counselors are selected based on experience in the arts and their experience with children. Counselors escort children throughout the entire camp day. We are able to provide more attention to each camper with our camper to counselor ratio of 6:1.



OUR CAMP SPACE

Campers love spending time at our fabulous facility! along with our outdoor spaces the Adirondack Club has spacious, air conditioned indoor areas where campers can run, play, create arts + crafts and even make a tasty treat to eat! Arts camp has its own contained space but campers also venture out during the day to other areas of the facility for different activities.
